Mission

The mission of the Department of the Navy civil liberties program is to implement the Department of Defense civil liberties program through advice, monitoring, official reporting, and training, as required by Section 803 of Public Law 110-53 limited to protecting civil liberties during exercise of power to protect the Nation against terrorism.

Advice and Monitoring

- Ensure DON compliance with civil liberties requirements (limited to protecting civil liberties during exercise of power to protect the Nation against terrorism)
 - DoDI 1000.29 “DoD Civil Liberties Program”
 - Office of the DON CIO, DON Civil Liberties Office

Reporting

- Reporting
 - Quarterly report sent to DoD on DON civil liberties program activities (limited to protecting civil liberties during exercise of power to protect the Nation against terrorism)
 - Policy reviews and advice
 - Allegations of civil liberties violations
 - Summary of the impact of program activities
 - Understanding of the current complaint reporting process
 - DoD compiles reports from components and sends to Congress




