RMKS/1. BACKGROUND. MOST COCOMS AND DCIP SECTORS, JCS, ASD(HD&ASA), DON CIO AND TWO OF THE FOUR DOD MILITARY SERVICES USE THE STRATEGIC MISSION ASSURANCE DATA SYSTEM (SMADS) AS THE REPOSITORY FOR THEIR TASK CRITICAL ASSETS (TCA'S). WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF THE NAVY, THE NAVY USES SMADS, AND THE MARINE CORPS USES AN INTERNAL SYSTEM CALLED MARINE CORPS CRITICAL ASSET MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (MCCAMS). PRESENTLY, THE DON CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE ASSURANCE OFFICER, COCOMS, DCIP SECTORS, JCS AND ASD (HD&ASA) DO NOT HAVE ONE SOURCE TO SEE ALL DON TCA'S ENTERED FROM ALL SOURCES.

2. POLICY. SMADS SHALL BE THE SINGLE AUTHORITATIVE SOURCE OF TCA'S FOR DEPARTMENT OF NAVY REPORTING. THIS POLICY DOES NOT PRECLUDE EITHER THE NAVY OR MARINE CORPS FROM MAINTAINING AND USING OTHER SOFTWARE CONTAINING DUPLICATE INFORMATION WITH SMADS TO MEET SERVICE SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS. THESE OTHER APPLICATIONS SHALL NOT BE AUTHORITATIVE. THIS CHANGE IN POLICY WILL BE INCORPORATED INTO THE 1.C VERSION OF THE SECNAVINST 3501 (SERIES), DEPARTMENT OF THE NAVY CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE PROTECTION.

3. ACTION. TO BETTER FACILITATE RAPID AND CONSISTENT DON LEVEL REPORTING, ALL DEPARTMENT OF THE NAVY TCA'S SHALL BE ENTERED INTO SMADS BY THE FOLLOWING DEADLINES:

A. ALL TIER ONE TCA'S BY 31 JANUARY 2010

B. ALL TIER TWO TCA'S BY 31 MARCH 2010

C. ALL TIER THREE TCA'S BY 31 MAY 2010
