RMKS/1. THIS IS A DEPARTMENT OF THE NAVY CHIEF INFORMATION OFFICER (DON CIO) MESSAGE TO RELEASE THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE INFORMATION ASSURANCE CERTIFICATION AND ACCREDITATION PROCESS (DIACAP) IMPLEMENTATION DOCUMENTS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF THE NAVY (DON).

2. BACKGROUND. THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE (DOD) MANDATED DIACAP AS THE NEW C&A PROCESS FOR THE DOD IN REF A. REF B INITIATED THE DON'S FULL TRANSITION TO DIACAP AND INDICATED PROMULGATION OF THE DIACAP GUIDANCE WOULD OCCUR NLT 15 MAY 2008.

3. THIS MESSAGE PROVIDES DON CIO SUPPORT AND APPROVAL OF TWO DIACAP IMPLEMENTATION DOCUMENTS: THE DIACAP TRANSITION GUIDE, AND THE DIACAP HANDBOOK.

4. THE DIACAP WORKING GROUP (DWG) CO-CHAIRS (THE NAVNETWARCOM OPERATIONAL DESIGNATED ACCREDITING AUTHORITY (DAA) AND THE HQMC C4/IA MARINE CORPS ENTERPRISE NETWORK (MCEN) DAA) SIGNED THE DIACAP TRANSITION GUIDE ON 19 MAY 2008. 5. THE DON DIACAP HANDBOOK IS IN THE FINAL STAGES OF APPROVAL. ONCE SIGNED BY THE DWG CO-CHAIRS, IT WILL BE POSTED ON THE DON CIO, NETWARCOM NEWS, AND HQMC C4/IA WEB SITES IDENTIFIED IN PARAGRAPH 4. THE PROJECTED POSTING DATE IS EARLY JUNE 2008. THE HANDBOOK PROVIDES A COMPREHENSIVE GUIDE FOR EXECUTING C&A PROCESSES WITHIN THE DON.

6. THE RELEASE OF THE DIACAP TRANSITION GUIDE AND HANDBOOK PROVIDES FURTHER INFORMATION FOR DON IMPLEMENTATION OF DIACAP. MANUAL PROCESSING OF DIACAP, USING THE DOCUMENTS, TEMPLATES, AND HANDBOOK PROVIDED, WILL CONTINUE UNTIL THE PROCUREMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF AN ENTERPRISE DON DIACAP TOOL IS COMPLETED. IF CHANGES ARE MADE TO THE TEMPLATES DURING MANUAL PROCESSING, THE LATEST VERSION WILL BE POSTED ON THE NETWARCOM WEB SITE LISTED IN PARAGRAPH 4 AND IN THE MARINE CORPS XACTA INFORMATION ASSURANCE MANAGER TOOL.
