RMKS/1. REF A CALLS FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF AN INFORMATION SHARING ENVIRONMENT (ISE) TO FACILITATE THE SHARING OF TERRORISM AND HOMELAND SECURITY INFORMATION. IAW SECTION 1016 OF REF A, THE PRESIDENT DIRECTED FEDERAL AGENCIES TO PROMOTE A CULTURE OF INFORMATION SHARING BY, AMONG OTHER THINGS, PROVIDING TRAINING.

2. THE PROGRAM MANAGER FOR THE ISE PRESCRIBED IMPLEMENTATION OF THE ISE CORE AWARENESS TRAINING COURSE. THIS COURSE PROVIDES A COMMON UNDERSTANDING OF THE ISE AND AN OVERVIEW OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT'S COUNTERTERRORISM ORGANIZATIONS, SYSTEMS, AND COMMON CHALLENGES.

3. BY REF B, ASD NII DIRECTED THAT ALL DOD PERSONNEL WHO USE TERRORISM-RELATED INFORMATION AND ARE ENGAGED IN LAW ENFORCEMENT, COUNTERTERRORISM, ANTITERRORISM, FORCE PROTECTION, COUNTERINTELLIGENCE, HOMELAND DEFENSE, OR COUNTER WEAPONS OF MASS DESTRUCTION TERRORISM ARE TO COMPLETE THIS TRAINING.

4. A. IAW REFS A AND B, REQUEST ADDRESSEES ENSURE THAT ALL PERSONNEL THAT MEET THE CRITERIA OF PARA 3, COMPLETE THE ISE CORE AWARENESS TRAINING COURSE NLT 31 AUG 09. THE COURSE IS LOCATED ON JFCOM JKO WEBSITE. DIRECTIONS FOR ACCESSING THE COURSE ARE AVAILABLE AT HTTPS://WWW.INTELINK.GOV/WIKI/ISE_AWARENESS.

4. B. THE COURSE REQUIRES 30 - 40 MINUTES TO COMPLETE. INDIVIDUAL COMMAND MUSTERS ARE NOT REQUIRED. THE LEARNING MANAGEMENT SYSTEM ON JKO AUTOMATICALLY TRACKS THE NUMBER OF COURSE COMPLETIONS BY MILDEP AND OCCUPATION CODES.

4. C. AS STATED IN THE DIRECTIONS, COURSE TAKERS MUST SELECT "RECEIVE CREDIT FOR THE MODULE" ON THE "COURSE LAUNCH" SCREEN FOR THE DON TO RECEIVE CREDIT FOR THE COMPLETED COURSE.
